Criterion and Summaries

Materials - Responsible material choices reducing environmental impact.

Production - Efficient, low-impact production with waste and energy reduction.

Supply Chain - Active management of sustainability across the supply chain.
Installation - Environmentally mindful installation with improved practices.

End of Life - Designed for reuse, recycling, or reduced waste outcomes.
